

- 2.1.21 organizes and coordinates appropriate resources in a timely manner in preparation for the subsequent patient; and
- 2.1.22 has knowledge and awareness of their health care organization's policies and procedures and implements appropriately.

2.2 Scrub role

The perioperative nurse:

- 2.2.1 acts as the patient's advocate during the surgical procedure;
- 2.2.2 sets priorities and expedites an efficient aseptic setup for each surgical procedure;
- 2.2.3 uses a surgical conscience to monitor aseptic technique throughout the procedure;
- 2.2.4 is vigilant and attentive throughout the surgical procedure and responds appropriately to complications and unexpected events;
- 2.2.5 applies knowledge and skills while anticipating and adapting to changes in the surgical procedure;
- 2.2.6 performs the surgical count concurrently with the circulating perioperative nurse;
- 2.2.7 demonstrates knowledge and function of instruments and equipment;
- 2.2.8 identifies malfunction or breakage of surgical instruments and equipment and responds appropriately to ensure the patient's and health care team's safety;
- 2.2.9 dismantles the surgical setup in a timely manner to contribute to an efficient turnover;
- 2.2.10 appropriately teaches and coaches learners throughout the surgical procedure; and
- 2.2.11 promotes appropriate communication techniques to keep noise at a minimum.

COMPETENCY 3: PROVIDES SUPPORTIVE CARE: PATIENT, FAMILY, AND HEALTH CARE TEAM MEMBERS

3.1 To the patient and family

The perioperative nurse:

- 3.1.1 establishes a therapeutic relationship that fosters trust and respect;
- 3.1.2 advocates and supports the right of the patient to make informed decisions;
- 3.1.3 provides explanations to assist patient with understanding the plan of care;
- 3.1.4 provides an environment in which the patient feels safe;
- 3.1.5 remains attentive to the needs of the patient throughout the perioperative period;
- 3.1.6 conveys a collaborative team approach; and
- 3.1.7 responds to complications, unusual occurrences, and harmful incidents.
