He reported that the board had been busy making changes and cool upgrades which had been undertaken along with the staff from First Stage Enterprises Ltd. He expressed his thank to Heather Jones and Ian Sinclair.

Having covered housekeeping items, Anthony introduced himself as having been a member since 2017. It was noted that some upgrades are still in process which will mean additional expenses will be incurred in the future. It was also noted that there will be an external review of the financials in the future as a matter of best practice.

As a new project, in the background work is being done to refresh the website. A preview of the new website was shown. While there is not a lot of new content it is planned to include member testimonials and links to other resources. A Twitter account has been set up which will be used to enhance social media presence.
